The Royal Life Saving ACT *Swim and Survive* program is a series of 10 half hour practical lessons focussed on general water safety and personal aquatic survival skills. This targeted approach will ensure every participating student has the opportunity to access structured aquatic activities during primary school.

The cost of the program is \$106.00 per student. You **DO NOT** have to send in any money. This has been included in your Term 4 school fees.
